

# Will, going to, Present Continuous to talk about future

We use **will** to talk about future when

- we make a decision at the moment of speaking:

*I'm sick and tired of this old wreck. I **will buy** a new car.*

- we make offers, promises, request

*I'll **help** you.*

*Will you **marry** me?*



We use **to be going to** to talk about future when

- we have plans and intentions for undefined future:

*When I finish school I'm **going to travel** around the world.*

*We **are going to get** married next year.*



We use **Present Continuous** to talk about future when

- we talk about arrangements for the nearest future:

*I have lots of cash on me because I'm **buying** a car today.*

*We **are getting** married this Saturday!*
