

# Will, going to, Present Continuous

## to talk about future

#### We use will to talk about future when

• we make a decision at the moment of speaking:

I'm sick and tired of this old wreck. I will buy a new car.

• we make offers, promises, request

I'll help you. Will you marry me?



### We use to be going to to talk about future when

• we have plans and intentions for undefined future:

When I finish school I'm going to travel around the world. We are going to get married next year.

#### We use **Present Continuous** to talk about future when

• we talk about arrangements for the nearest future:

I have lots of cash on me because I'm buying a car today. We are getting married this Saturday!
